# Are you curious about global affairs? Do you like learning about different cultures? Apply to be a Gulf Coast Diplomacy Youth Diplomat!

#### What's the commitment?

- Attend 7 of 9 regular sessions one Saturday per month, Aug 2025April 2026 and either Camp Global in June or the *Faces of*Service leadership days in July. Attending either of the two
  summer sessions counts as a make-up for a missed regular
  meeting and Youth Diplomats are encouraged to attend both;
- Produce one blog post or social media post; and
- Read the materials provided at the end of each session to be ready to engage at the next month's session.

#### What are the benefits?

Youth Diplomats:

- Develop 21st century skills including critical thinking, collaboration & leadership development;
- Strengthen their knowledge of global affairs;
- Earn community service hours alongside international exchange participants;
- Earn digital credentials aligned with the Open Badges standard; and
- Have access to an array of scholarships promoting international exchange and language proficiency.

#### How much does it cost?

- Tuition for the year is \$120.
- Need-based tuition wavers are available.

#### Sample Activities

Past Youth Diplomats:

- Explored the Peace Corps & the U.S. Foreign Service;
- Participated in diplomatic simulations;
- Explored intercultural communication, the situation in Ukraine, and historic preservation in Albania;
- Engaged in activities with teens from Central America and Kosovo;
- Met with professionals from Armenia, Morocco, & Pakistan; and
- Built friendships across our region and the world.
